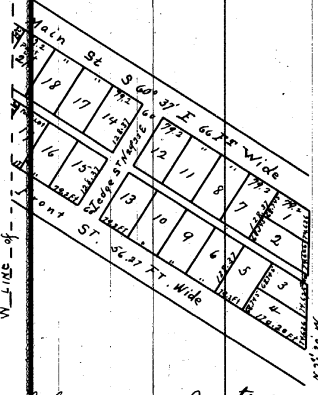

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CITY OF GRAND LEDGE RESOLUTION NUMBER 3 OF 1985

RESOLUTION VACATING, DISCONTINUING AND ABANDONING THE 20 FOOT ALLEYWAY CONTAINED IN THE PLAT OF T. H. HARRIS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GRAND LEDGE, ACCORDING TO THE RECORDED PLAT THEREOF, SAID ALLEYWAY BEING BOUNDED ON THE WEST BY THE RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND BEING BOUNDED ON THE EAST BY EMERSON STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Grand Ledge has determined that the 20 foot alleyway located within the Plat of the T. H. Harris Addition to the City of Grand Ledge, said alleyway commencing at the Railroad Right-of-Way to the West of Lots 18 and 19 in said Plat, and thence running Easterly to its intersection with Emerson Street in the City, serves no public purpose in its present condition, and that no public benefit is derived therefrom, and

WHEREAS, it is determined that said alleyway will not be necessary for future anticipated uses by the City, NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City of Grand Ledge hereby vacate, discontinue and abolish the said alleyway described above and legally described hereinafter.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that objections to the vacation, discontinuance or abandonment of said alleyway will be heard at the regular meeting of the Grand Ledge City Council to be held on Monday, March 11, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Grand Ledge City Hall, Grand Ledge, Michigan.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that a notice of this meeting, together with a copy of this Resolution, shall be published in the GRAND LEDGE INDEPENDENT for not less than four (4) weeks prior to the March 11, 1985 meeting of the Council.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that objections to the vacation, discontinuance and abandonment of the aforesaid alley may be filed in writing with the Grand Ledge City Clerk, and, if such objections shall be filed, that the alley shall not be vacated, discontinued or abandoned except by concurring vote of 2/3 of the Council elect.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that following final adoption of this Resolution, that the Grand Ledge City Clerk shall cause a true copy to be recorded in the book of Street Records in the Office of Eaton County Register of Deeds, and in the Bureau of Local Government Services of the State of Michigan.

The alleyway being vacated, discontinued and abandoned is legally described as follows:

That certain piece or parcel located within the T. H. Harris Addition to the City of Grand Ledge, and shown on the plat thereof as a dedicated alley being legally described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 2 in said Addition, thence Northwesterly along the Southwesterly line of Lots 2, 7, 8, 11 and 12 to the Southwest corner of said Lot 12; thence Southwesterly parallel to Ledge Street to the Northwest corner of Lot 13 in said Addition; thence Southeasterly along the Northeasterly line of Lots 13, 10, 9, 6, 5 and 3 to the Northeast corner of said Lot 3; thence North parallel with Emerson Street to the point of beginning.

Also, commencing at the Southeasterly corner of Lot 14 in said Addition, thence Northwesterly along the Southwest line of Lots 14, 17 and 18 to the Southwest corner of said Lot 18 of said Addition; thence Southwesterly along the railroad right-of-way to the Northwest corner of Lot 19 of said Addition; thence Southeasterly along the North-

easterly line of Lots 19, 16 and 15 to the Northeasterly corner of said Lot 15; thence Northeasterly parallel to Ledge Street to the point of beginning.
