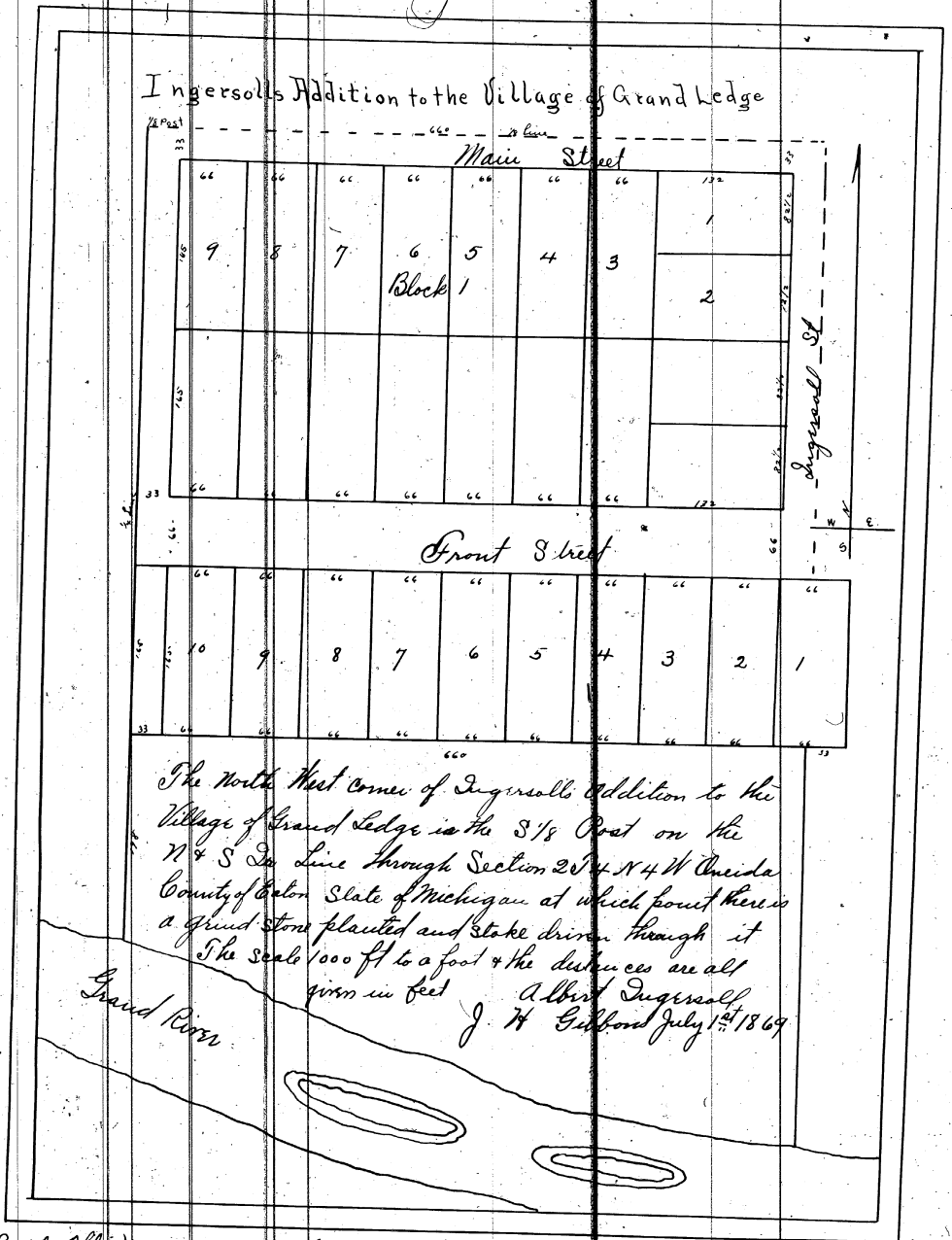


Ingersoll's Addition to the Village of Grand Ledge



The North West corner of Ingersoll's Addition to the Village of Grand Ledge is the 3 1/8 Post on the N & S In Line through Section 25 & N 4 W Oneida County of Eaton State of Michigan at which point there is a ground stone planted and stake driven through it.
