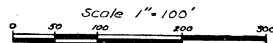
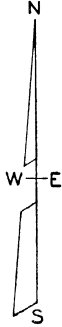
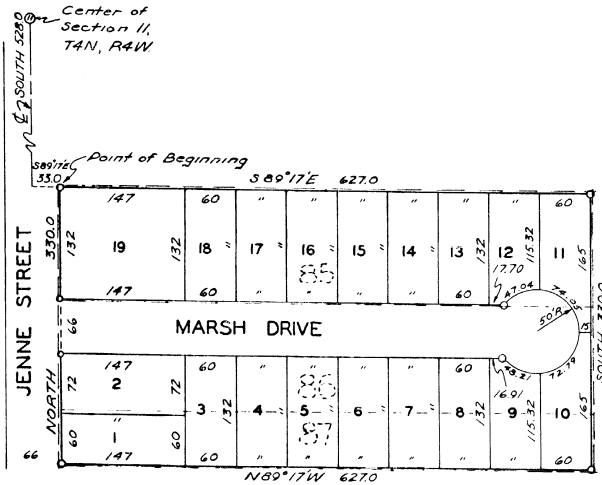

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of MARSH SUBDIVISION on part of the SE 1/4 of Section 11, T4N, R4W, City of Grand Ledge, Eaton County, Michigan is described as follows: Beginning at a point South 528.0 feet and S89°17'E 33.0 feet from the center of Section 11, T4N, R4W, City of Grand Ledge, Eaton County, Michigan, said point being on the East line of Jenne Street 66 feet wide, running thence S89°17'E 627.0 feet, thence South 330.0 feet, thence N89°17'W 627.0 feet to the East line of Jenne Street, thence North 330.0 feet to the point of beginning, being a replat of Lots 85, 86 and 87 of Supervisor's Plat No. 2 of City of Grand Ledge, and containing lots 1 to 19, incl.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consisting of bars not less than one-half inch in diameter and 36 inches in length, or shorter bars of not less than one-half inch in diameter lapped over each other at least 6 inches with an over-all length of not less than 36 inches, enclosed in a concrete cylinder at least 4 inches in diameter and 36 inches in depth have been placed at points marked thus (O) as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, of all the intersections of streets, intersections of alleys, or of streets and alleys, and of the intersections of streets and alleys with the boundaries of the plat as shown on said plat.
