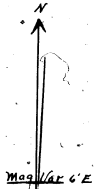
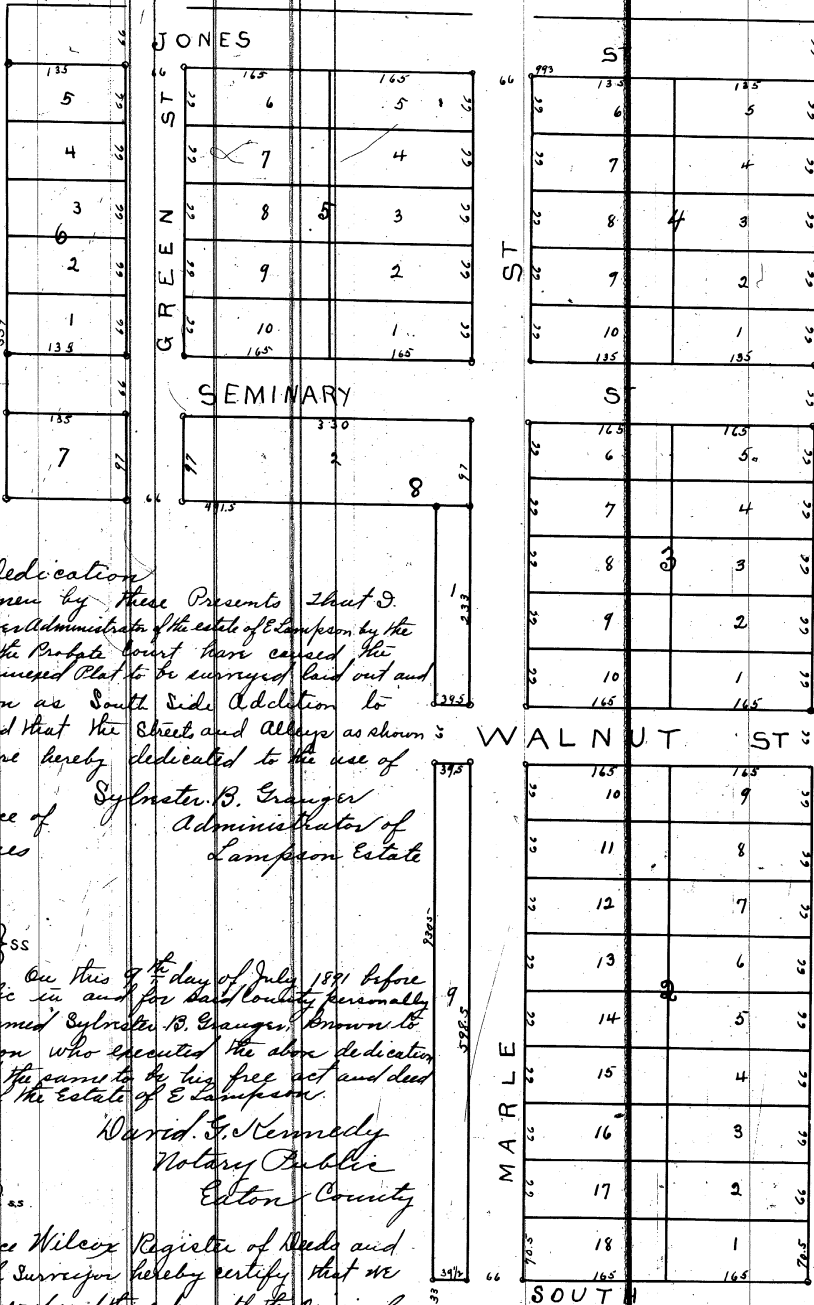


SOUTH SIDE ADDITION
